


Stiff Stay Fencing Machine
Centre Twist Retrofit










With the use of a hinged apron on the top and bottom of the fence several applications can arise for both improved containment of animals and exclusion of predators/pests. Below are two examples for the centre twist Stiff Stay fence.



Both the height of the fence and the length of the apron can be configured to suit individual needs. The apron can be placed at any angle depending on the application.

With traditional Stiff Stay fence, without a hinge, the fence must either be bent or have a second shorter section of fence tied to the horizontal wire. Both these options require greater installation time and can place unnecessary strain on the fence and fence posts. By introducing the centre twist, the fence can be easily angled during installation. This will not only produce a more resilient fence but will also decrease installation time and save money.
